“Love & fair discipline...the missing link”

With much discussion on the issue of alcohol abuse taking place this week at The NSW Alcohol Summit, Ron Barr the founder of the innovative and highly successful Youth Insearch program believes that we need to explore in depth the reasons of why young people fall into a path of self destruction.

Ron believes that a major issue affecting our society is the breakdown in the family unit.

“From what I have seen from attending hundreds of Youth Insearch Camps over the last 18 years, kids are starving for love and fair discipline. We need to focus more on the responsibility of being a parent” said Ron.

“Most of us can become parents, but not all can be a Mum & a Dad. It is more than just clothing them and making sure they are fed, it is about giving them unconditional love...children learn what they live” said Ron.

Since 1985, Youth Insearch has been re-building the lives of over 24,000 young people with some amazing success stories. It has been featured on 60 Minutes, A Current Affair, the 7.30 Report and the Australian Story.
