# **48 HOUR DASH FROM MELBOURNE TO SYDNEY TO RAISE MONEY FOR YOUTH INSEARCH**

Sydney Stockbroker Daryl Allen has set himself another marathon challenge on wheels to raise funds for his favourite charity Youth Insearch.

He will attempt to take his personal fundraising effort to over \$1M mostly from the broking community with past challenges like riding his bike for 24 hours around Centennial Park on two occasions and running a 42km marathon on soft sand at Manly Beach.

At 2.00am on Friday April 30<sup>th</sup> he will set out to ride his bike up the Hume Highway from Melbourne to Sydney in 48 Hours!

Every cent raised will go towards the final payment for the purchase of the Kurrajong Heights retreat in the Blue Mountains for Youth Insearch to conduct their highly successful program in re-building kids lives.

Youth Insearch conducts weekend Camps for 50 young people between 14-18 years of age from differing backgrounds and lifestyles. At the Camps, a safe and trusting atmosphere is created where young people feel comfortable to discuss emotional issues relating to family breakdown, drug and alcohol abuse, sexual abuse and grief related issues.

Participants are able to draw on the experiences from each other and establish new goals and directions.

Riding with Daryl will be a team of 4 support riders including The Communications Group (George Pattersons Partners) Chairman Alex Hamill and Hymix MD Tony Browne.
